ISO 14001 is the internationally recognised standard for the environmental management of businesses. Implementing an Environmental Management System is the best way to control the effects your company has on the environment. Cost savings can be made through improved efficiency and productivity by detecting ways to use resources more efficiently, minimising waste production and disposing of it more effectively. It verifies compliance with current legislation and makes insurance cover more accessible.

What's involved?

Initially, one of our assessors will visit to look at your business processes, systems and activities, and determine how they address the requirements of ISO 14001, and will identify any potential non-compliances. If you have an ISO 9001 system already in place then many of the requirements of ISO 14001 will already be covered or can be easily incorporated.

Our auditors are IRCA Lead Assessor trained, and able to offer clear and simple expert advice. A second visit to your site, about 4 weeks later, checks compliance with ISO 14001. On successful completion of this process a certificate is issued. An annual external audit is required to maintain your certificate.
